 - If your guidance counselor cannot send your test scores, you must request them from the testing agency. Shenandoah's SAT code is 5613 and its ACT code is 4396.
 - Send 1 letter of recommendation.
 - Conservatory applicants must register for an audition or portfolio review. It is required.
 - If applicable, submit official transcripts of any college or university courses completed while in high school.
 - If applicable, submit official test results for Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate or CLEP exams.
- Home Schooled applicants** must provide a detailed transcript of all coursework completed beginning in the ninth grade in lieu of a high school transcript.
- GED applicants** must provide an official General Education Development (GED) score report in lieu of a high school transcript.
