Practicum Placement Identification Number: PSY 401D-101

Description of Practicum Placement: This practicum placement involves providing in-home behavior therapy to children with autism for a minimum of two 3-hour sessions per week. Students will be providing treatment under the supervision of an Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) Specialist, who will continue to monitor treatment for the duration of the practicum placement.

Availability: 0-3 positions depending on site need; Offered every Fall and Spring semester

Special Prerequisites: Successful completion of PSY 330 (Behavior Modification)

Hours Required: 120

Other Requirements: Initial training with ABA specialist; Meet twice monthly with psychology faculty advisor; Meet twice monthly with ABA specialist; Complete 4- to 6-page reflection paper describing practicum experiences and how you were able to apply psychological principles to personal, social, and organizational issues encountered during your placement
