

Graduate Assistant General Information

Graduate Assistantships are available for the Fall and Spring semesters. There are a limited number of slots. Applications must be submitted to be considered for a position by the deadlines stated on the applications available below.

How they work:

We have two types of assistantships available -- Full & Half (details below)

- Full Assistantship -- 9 credit hours of tuition are waived; assistant works 20 hours per week
- Half Assistantship -- 4.5 credit hours of tuition are waived; assistant works 10 hours per week
- Both also provide a small monetary stipend that is distributed directly to the student throughout the semester.

Criteria:

- Students must be accepted into the program prior to applying.
- Foundation courses must be waived and/or completed.
- Students must be enrolled full-time (minimum of 9 credits) in the semester they apply for.
- Applications will be considered for a number of factors to include, but not limited to, experience, academic merit, and financial need
