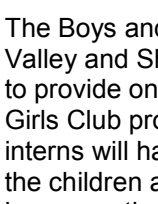

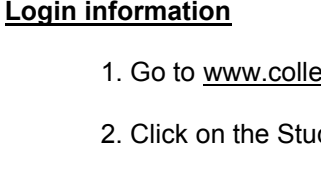

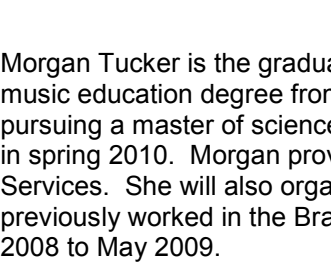
To join College Central Network, follow the instructions below.

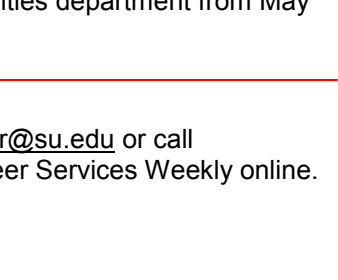
