Georgetown University is offering online coursework for teaching English as a second language certificate program August 10—December 18, 2009.

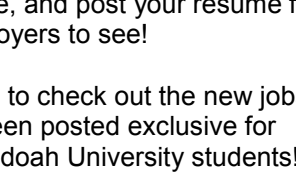
The University is also offering on-campus teaching practice Saturdays: Nov. 7, 14, 21, and Dec. 5, 12, 2009.

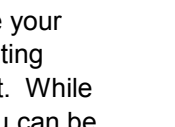
Career Services at Shenandoah University uses an on-line job posting system to alert students to part- and full-time jobs and internships. To join College Central Network, follow the instructions below.
