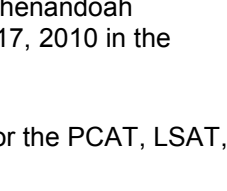

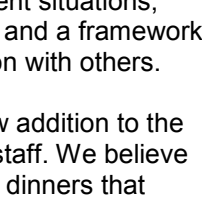
Kaplan Test Prep will be coming to Shenandoah University on Wednesday, February 17, 2010 in the Brandt Student Center lower level.

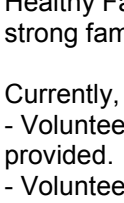

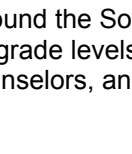
Healthy Families vision is of a healthy, safe and supportive community comprised of strong families and individuals working together to help children reach their full potential.

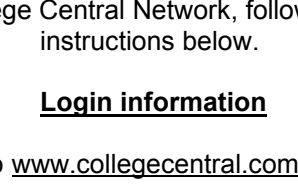

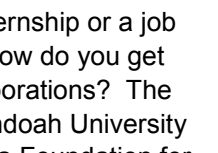
Career Services at Shenandoah University uses an on-line job posting system to alert students to part- and full-time jobs and internships. To join College Central Network, follow the instructions below.
