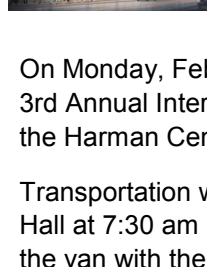

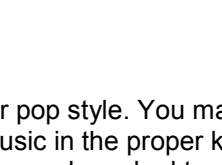

## East Campus Housing Resume Presentation



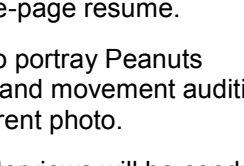
The Career Services Office will be providing a resume presentation on Thursday, January 28, 2010 at 8 pm in the Romine Conference Room on-campus.

## Kings Dominion On-Campus Auditions



Friday, February 5, 2010 from 7—10 pm in Ruebush 148, Kings Dominion will be on-campus to audition students. 7 pm until 8:30 pm is for singers, actors, variety acts, musicians, and characters and 8:30 pm until 10 pm is for dancers, stage managers, technicians, costumers, and theatre attendants.

Audition Information:

**SINGERS**—Prepare at least one up-tempo and one ballad in rock or pop style. You may not sing a cappella. An accompanist will be provided. Bring sheet music in the proper key or prerecorded instrumental tracks (without lead vocals) on CD. You may be asked to read a brief monologue and to dance, so bring appropriate clothes and shoes for movement. Please also bring a current photo and a one-page resume.

**DANCERS**—You will be taught a combination (jazz, ballet, hip-hop, acrobatics, etc) during the audition. (If you sing, please bring music as specified above.) Please come prepared in comfortable and appropriate clothing and shoes. Please also bring a current photo and a one-page resume.

**ACTORS**—Please prepare a humorous, family-oriented monologue of no longer than 2 minutes in length that displays your personality, comedic ability, and announcing style. Please bring a current photo and a one-page resume.

**VARIETY ARTISTS**—We are looking for unique and creative acts. If you are an experienced performance artist with a unique approach to entertainment, please prepare a montage of your best work no longer than 4 minutes in length. Please bring a current photo and a one-page resume.

**MUSICIANS**—We are looking for all instruments. Please come prepared to perform two contrasting pieces, with one piece being in a pop style. We will audition individuals as well as existing bands. Please bring a current photo and a one-page resume.

**CHARACTERS** – We are looking for enthusiastic individuals to portray Peanuts Characters. You must be between 4'10" to 5'4". An interview and movement audition will be conducted. Please bring a one page resume and a current photo.

**TECHNICIANS/COSTUMERS/THEATRE ATTENDANTS**—Interviews will be conducted for experienced sound operators, lighting operators, follow spot operators, stage crew, costumers, and theatre attendants. Interviews will be held on a first come first serve basis. Please bring a one-page resume with references.

**STAGE MANAGERS & SUPERVISORS**—We are looking for experienced Stage Managers, skilled costume supervisors with administrative and construction experience, character supervisors, and theatre attendant supervisors to manage a variety of show products.

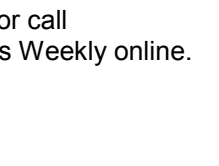
