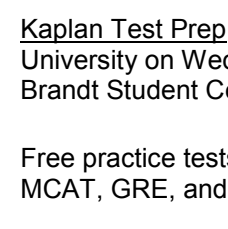

Kaplan Test Prep will be coming to Shenandoah University on Wednesday, February 17, 2010 in the Brandt Student Center lower level.

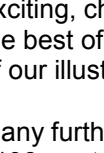
Free practice tests will be available for the PCAT, LSAT, MCAT, GRE, and NCLEX.

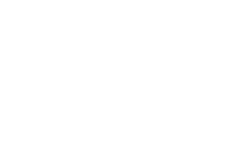
### On-Campus Employer: Marine Corps

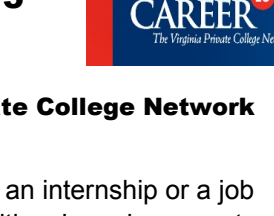

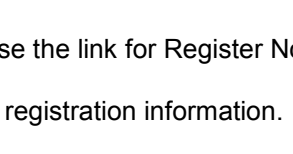

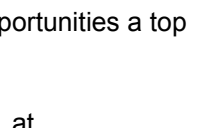
Career Services at Shenandoah University uses an on-line job posting system to alert students to part- and full-time jobs and internships. To join College Central Network, follow the instructions below.
