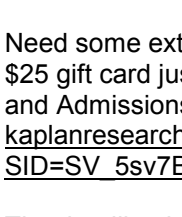

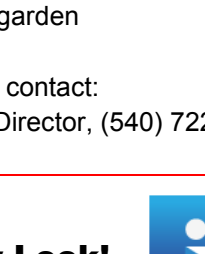
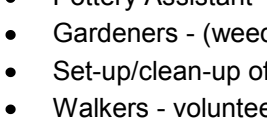

The Adult Care Center of the Northern Shenandoah Valley provides quality adult day health care for persons with Alzheimer's Disease and others requiring supervised care.

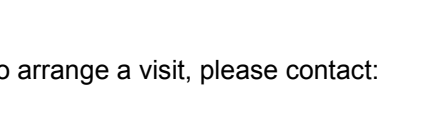
Volunteers are needed to assist patients with varying levels of Alzheimer's or dementia with the following activities...

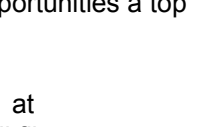
Career Services at Shenandoah University uses an on-line job posting system to alert students to part- and full-time jobs and internships. To join College Central Network, follow the instructions below.
