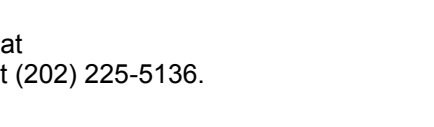
## Enterprise Rent-A-Car Interviews On-Campus

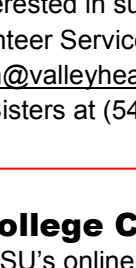
Among the employers scheduled to participate are BB&T, the Virginia State Police, FedEx Ground, Windward IT Solutions, Transportation Security Administration - Dulles, Project Hope and Comcast. Big Brothers Big Sisters of Winchester, Frederick, and Clarke Counties works hard in the community to help children reach

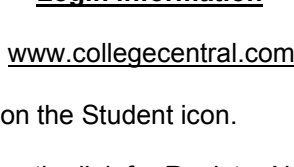

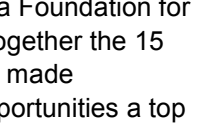
Career Services at Shenandoah University uses an on-line job posting system to alert students to part- and full-time jobs and internships. To join College Central Network, follow the instructions below.
