China Studies Institute

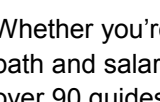
Students and graduates can intern at a cultural organization with high level staff in Beijing or Shanghai, all arranged by the China Studies Institute and **International Arts & Artists** (IA&A). The Institute also arranges affordable housing, weekend study trips, orientation, internship seminar, and faculty support. The brochure is at www.china-studies.net/brochure.pdf and The Institute has an excellent record of placing students in the perfect internship. The brochure includes history of the programs, pictures, anecdotes from past students, class descriptions and fee information.

International Arts & Artists' partnership with the Institute began in 2007, but the Institute's programs are 30 years old. They were one of the first US programs in China when China started opening up after the Mao Zedong era. The Institute originated as a partner of American

University and is now completely separate but still working with AU and several other universities, including George Washington University. Dr. Youli Sun, a published author, is the director and founder. IA&A's role is to make the program available to arts and culture-related students and alumni.

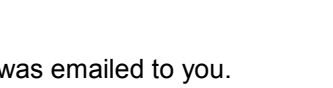

Vault—Online Career Library



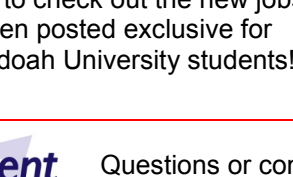

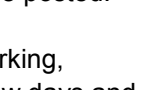
Career Services at Shenandoah University uses an on-line job posting system to alert students to part- and full-time jobs and internships. To join College Central Network, follow the instructions below.
