



Professional Studies Certificate for Teacher Licensure

The Professional Studies Certificate programs for elementary, middle, and/or secondary teacher education licensure serve candidates wishing to obtain Virginia Teacher Licensure. Candidates completing the requirements for these programs will meet the Virginia Department of Education (VDOE) requirements for licensure in at least one endorsement area in which the university offers programs. Secondary school licensure is offered in biology, chemistry, history/social studies, English, Spanish, and mathematics. K-12 licensure is offered in music – instrumental, dance, vocal, health and physical education, and special education – general. Elementary school licensure is offered in PK-6 and Pre-K-3, and middle school licensure is offered in grades 6-8. The technology and child protection state requirements for approved licensure programs are met within the courses in the PSC program.

To complete the PSC, candidates must earn 15-24 credits (depending on endorsement or licensure area). Up to 18 PSC credits earned to complete the PSC may be transferred into the Master of Science in Education – Individualized Focus, allowing the candidate to complete both licensure and graduate degree requirements.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Graduate Application for Admission along with a \$30 non-refundable application fee
- Official transcripts from all institutions of higher education previously attended
- 3 letters of recommendation
- Typed essay/writing sample
- Passing Praxis I test scores (Consult admissions about SAT/ACT substitute tests)
- Criminal background check

TRANSFER CREDITS

- Only grades of “A” or “B” are transferable
- Graduate hours may be approved by the Director of the School of Education & Human Development
