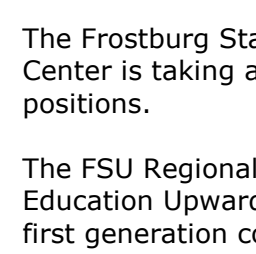

The Frostburg State University, Upward Bound Regional Math Science Center is taking applications for teaching and summer residential counseling positions.

The FSU Regional Math/Science is a federally funded Department of Education Upward Bound program designed to help low-income, potential first generation college students achieve their goals of attaining a college degree, specifically in the fields of math and science. Participants in the program attend a six-week summer session on the campus of FSU where they are engaged in a scientific research project. The RMSC strives to develop exciting hands-on projects that are relevant to modern life.

Positions Available:

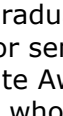
Tutor/Counselor Position—These are residential positions and Tutor Counselors are responsible for supervising program participants in the residence halls and during all RMSC sponsored activities. Tutor Counselors attend academic classes with the students and assist them as they complete their scientific investigations.

Head Resident—This is a residential position where staff members plan and lead recreational, initiative, and team building activities for the residents. Head Residents work closely with administrative staff and help with staff development programs.

Teaching Positions—RMSC are looking for regional science, English, and mathematics teachers for the summer 2012 program.

2012 Scholarship and Career Awards Program

Lighthouse International is now accepting applications for its 2012 Scholarship and Career Awards program. Please visit www.lighthouse.org/sca to complete the online application.

These scholarships reward academic excellence, recognize accomplishments and help students who are blind or partially sighted pursue their academic and career goals. There are three scholarship award categories, and each carries a \$10,000 prize.

College-bound Award: for high school seniors or recent high school graduates who will attend college in the upcoming school year.

Undergraduate Award: for college students in their freshman, sophomore, junior or senior year.

Graduate Award: for first or second year masters level students or college seniors who will pursue a graduate level education.

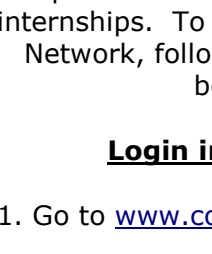
Candidates may apply at any time immediately, prior to, or during their course of study. A total of six scholarships will be awarded across these three categories.

Students interested in applying for a scholarship must meet the following criteria:

- Applicants must be legally blind (i.e., have a best corrected visual acuity of 20/200 or less in the better eye, and/or a visual field of less than 20 degrees in the better eye).
- Scholarships are based on academic and personal achievements. Therefore, candidates are not required to demonstrate financial need.
- Applicants must be US citizens, and reside in the United States or a US Territory.
- Applicants must attend an accredited college or university in one of the 50 states, District of Columbia or a US territory. Proof of citizenship will be required of all award recipients.
- Previous SCA recipients and current Lighthouse employees and members of their immediate families are ineligible.

The application and all requested documentation must be submitted online no later than **Friday, February 3, 2012**.
