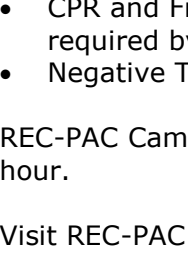

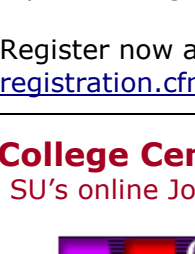

You must bring your original social security card (for tax purposes) and employee eligibility verification (i.e. Drivers license, passport or school photo ID). Please bring a voided check to assist in setting up direct deposit for your pay-check.

Mandatory Requirements for all positions:

- Must have experience working with children/teens in a group setting.
- Must be at least 18 years of age and a high school graduate.
- CPR and First Aid (Child and Adult) valid through August 2012—required by June 26
- Negative TB test result— required by June 26.

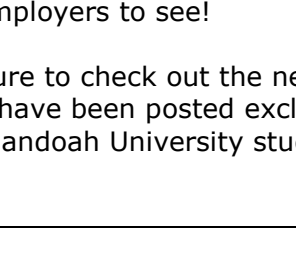
IMI 13th Annual Conference on Intercultural Relations
