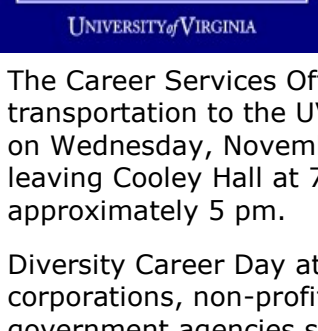

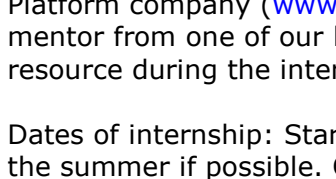
Wednesday November 2, Transportation Provided!

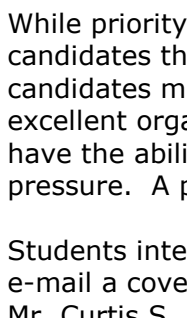
Schools of Public Visit Day November 2

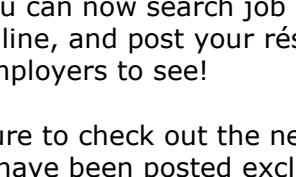

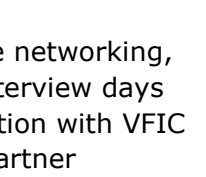
Career Services at Shenandoah University uses an on-line job posting system to alert students to part- and full-time jobs and internships. To join College Central Network, follow the instructions below.
