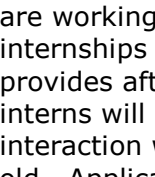

Since then ODK has taken firm root in 298 colleges and universities around the nation. Omicron Delta Kappa places emphasis upon the development of the whole person, both as a present member of his/her college community and as a prospective contributor to a better society.

Student Requirements

To become a member of ODK, students must meet the following minimum requirements:

- Junior (3.2 GPA or higher), Senior (3.3 GPA or higher), or Graduate student (3.5 GPA or higher) standing.
- One-half academic year of residence in the institution where elected.
- A minimum cumulative grade point average of:

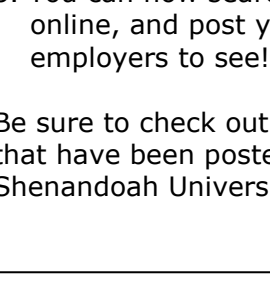
The achievement of special distinction in at least one of the five major areas of leadership listed below:

- Athletics
- Campus or Community Service/Social & Religious Activities and Campus Governance
- Journalism, Speech, Mass Media
- Creative and Performing Arts

Faculty Requirements

Faculty members shall be those members of the faculty or the administrative staff of Shenandoah University, selected and initiated into membership by a Circle as faculty members or members formerly initiated who may subsequently serve on the faculty or staff of such an institution.
