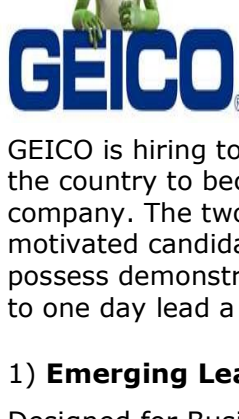

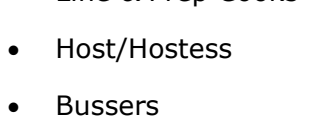

Anne Wexler Scholarships in Public Policy Available

Applications for the 2012 Anne Wexler Scholarship Programs in Public Policy are available until September 30, 2011. Two Anne Wexler Scholarships will be awarded annually. One for an Australian citizen to complete in a U.S. Master's degree program in Public Policy, and one for a U.S. citizen to complete an Australian Master's program in Public Policy areas. Areas of study may include health, sustainability, energy, climate change, regional security, political science, history or governmental relations, amongst others.

The scholarships are administered by the Australian-American Fulbright Commission in Canberra, and funded by the Australian Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations. The Anne Wexler Scholarships are part of the Australian Government's Australia Awards Program.

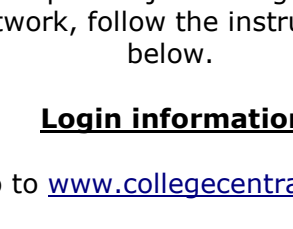

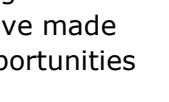
Career Services at Shenandoah University uses an on-line job posting system to alert students to part- and full-time jobs and internships. To join College Central Network, follow the instructions below.
