### TEAS EXAM

#### A Test of Essential Academic Skills

The Division of Nursing is committed to facilitating students' success. It is for this reason that we use the TEAS (Test of Essential Skills™) exam to evaluate students' academic readiness for admission to the nursing program. An overall score of 65% is required for admission. Please pay close attention to the information written below.

The TEAS exam consists of four content areas: Reading, Math, Science, and English and Language Usage. All subtests contain multiple-choice items with one correct answer. The test is timed and will last approximately 3 ½ hours.

- **Math** subtest covers whole numbers, metric conversion, fractions, decimals, algebraic equations, percentages and ratio/proportion.
- **Reading** covers paragraph comprehension, passage comprehension and inferences/conclusions.
- **English and Language Usage** subtest measures knowledge of punctuation, grammar, sentence structure, contextual words and spelling.
- **Science** covers science reasoning, science knowledge, biology, chemistry, anatomy, physiology, basic physical principles, and general science.

The TEAS exam is produced by Assessment Technologies Incorporated (ATI), a testing company that offers standardized entrance testing and comprehensive examinations for schools of nursing in the United States. The ATI-TEAS is administered online, and results are available immediately at the conclusion of the test.

The TEAS exam is administered at the Shenandoah University Health Professions Building which is located on the campus of the Winchester Medical Center.

#### Test guidelines – the day of the TEAS exam

Students must bring a picture ID to the test session and two pencils.

No other items are allowed in the testing area. This includes: handbags, backpacks, cell phones, hats or calculators.

You should arrive 20 minutes early for the exam.
