DIRECTOR

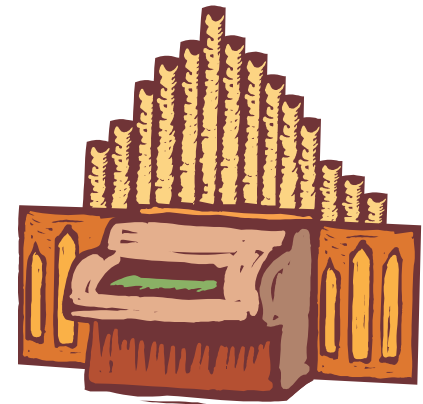

## WHAT IS AN ORGAN ACADEMY?

This is a 2 week introduction to the pipe organ and electronic keyboard instruments found in church services today. Most middle and high school students are at the perfect age to begin Church music training, in order to later provide service to the church. This service could include the training of substitutes and/or accompanists for local congregations.

The students will learn basic organ technique, available literature and repertoire, and enjoy sessions on “The King of Instruments” – the pipe organ.

**Each student is invited to attend all workshops and services during the 2 weeks at CMI on the campus of Shenandoah at no cost.** They will also attend a class each week on “How to use the stops on the Organ to make music and lead congregational singing.” They will also be asked to attend a class on service playing – including – “What do I do with my feet?”

The classes and lessons will be held at Braddock St. United Methodist Church.

## WHAT IS THE COST AND WHAT WILL IT INCLUDE?

The total cost is \$90.00. Each student will receive:

1. 4 - 30 minute private lessons (2 per week). Scheduled to accommodate student.
2. 2 - 1 hour classes on service playing. Tues. 3:00 p.m. .
3. 2 - 1 hour classes in registration – learning how to use the organ stops to make your music sound great. Thurs., 3:00 p.m.,

Private lessons can be scheduled prior to or after classes or other times indicated on registration form.

The director will assist in making practice arrangements.

## WHAT TEACHING MATERIALS WILL BE USED?

We will be using “Basic Organ Repertoire,” “Modern Keyboard Techniques,” “Modern Hymn Playing,” by Dr. Wayne Leupold, church hymnals, and the “Cadenza Method for Organ,” by Judy Connelly and Charles Leeper. Materials will be available for purchase or may be checked out with the instructor for temporary use.
