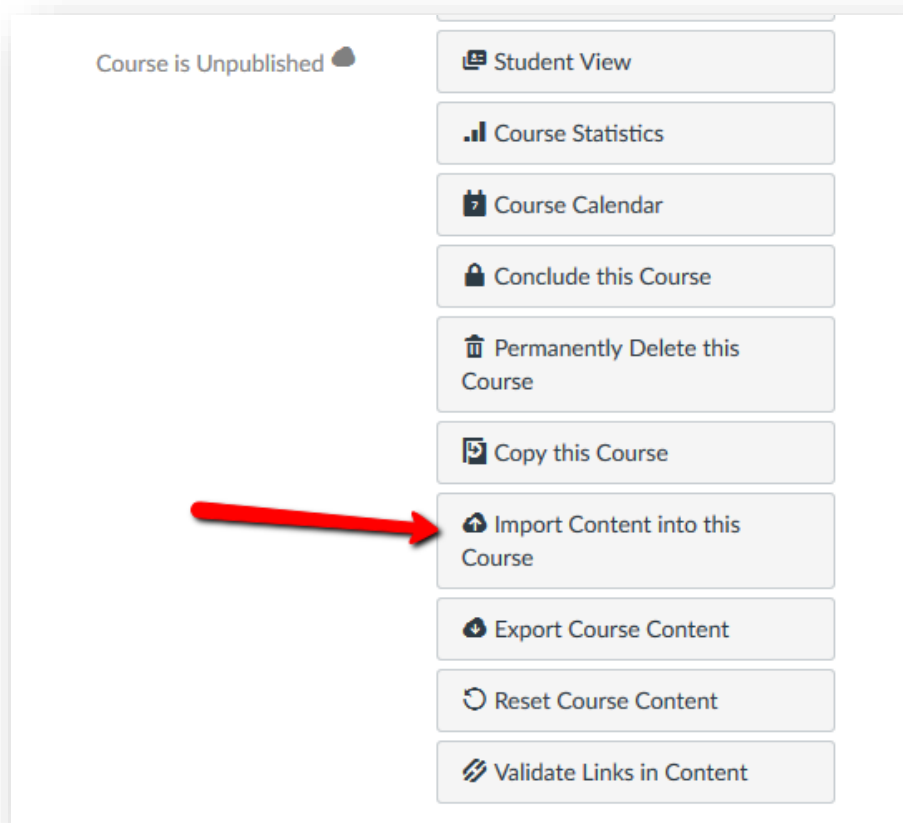
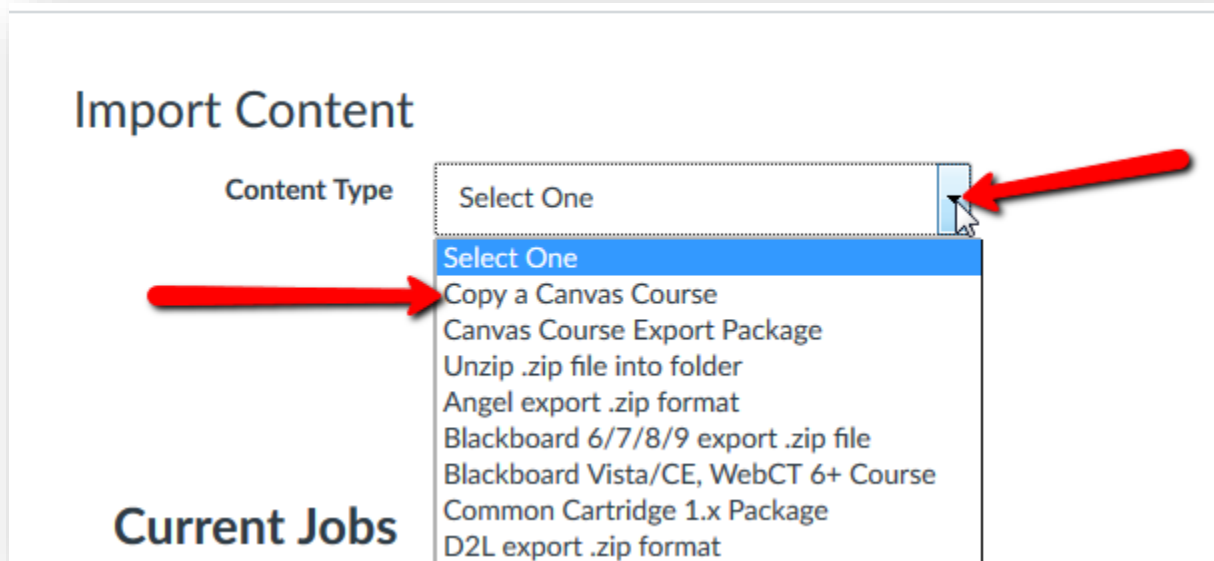


CANVAS: Copying from Course to Course

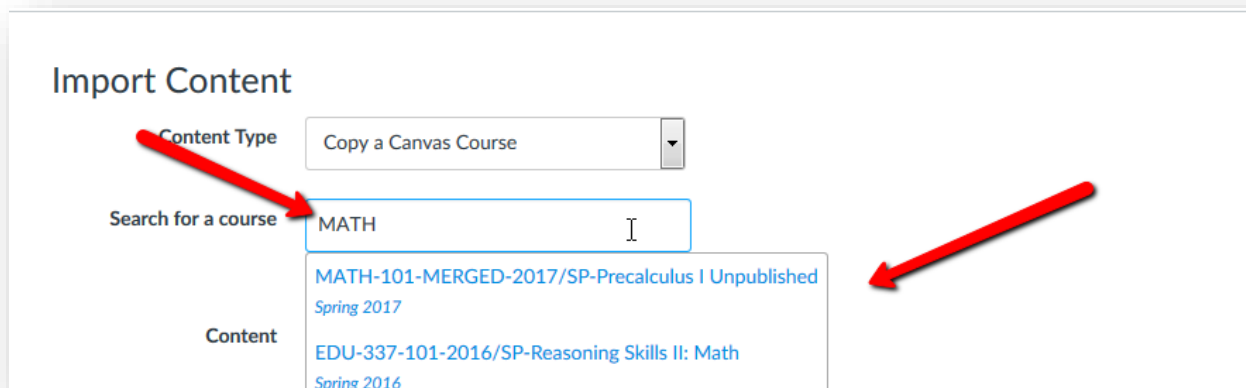
You can copy content directly from one Canvas course to another using the **IMPORT CONTENT** command in the 'destination' course. (The course into which you wish to copy the content.)

In the destination course, click on **SETTINGS** in the navigation menu. Once in **SETTINGS**, click on **IMPORT CONTENT INTO THIS COURSE**, far right.





From the **CONTENT TYPE** drop-down menu, select **COPY A CANVAS COURSE**.



Begin typing the course ID of the 'source course' (or the course from which you wish to copy the content) and select the appropriate course from the list as it appears.






Select either **ALL CONTENT**, or **SELECT SPECIFIC CONTENT**, depending on your goal.

ALL CONTENT, of course, will bring all the content from the source course to the destination course. If you choose **SELECT SPECIFIC CONTENT**, you will then be prompted with another button below to select the content you wish to copy over.
