WHY A BBA?

The BBA gives you a solid foundation in general business and offers flexibility and diversity in career preparation. All concentrations offer opportunities for internships, project-based experiential learning and international travel.

ACCOUNTING

The accounting concentration provides a framework for careers as public or management accountants and meets all of the educational requirements of the Commonwealth of Virginia to take the CPA exam.

AVIATION STUDIES

The aviation concentration provides a pathway for students who already hold an FAA certified private pilot's license, instrument rating and two additional flight certifications* to complete a bachelor's degree with fewer credits due to aviation credits counted. **FAA flight training and instrument rating are not available at Shenandoah University.*

BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

The business administration concentration provides a broad background in a variety of important foundational areas including accounting, data analytics, entrepreneurship, finance, human resources, organizational behavior, management, marketing, international trade, strategy, law, and ethics.

DIGITAL MARKETING

Digital marketing focuses on tactics including SEO (Search Engine Optimization), SEM (Search Engine Marketing), social media marketing, online advertising, email marketing, mobile marketing, and content marketing. Students will do hands-on projects with real clients and develop skills in crafting advertising, performing keyword

research, and using tools for image and video creation. Program content is aligned with recognized industry certifications including Google Ads, Google Analytics, HubSpot Inbound and the American Marketing Association's Professional Certified Marketer Certificate.

ECONOMICS & FINANCE

The economics and finance concentration prepares students for careers in general business and government, particularly in the financial services industry, as well as for advanced studies in economics and finance. The program prepares students with the content necessary to take exams for Chartered Financial Analyst (CFA) professional status.

ENTREPRENEURSHIP

In today's gig economy, the entrepreneurship concentration's most valuable lesson teaches learners how to think like an owner. Whether you plan to start your own business, join a family business, or become part of a firm or corporation, entrepreneurship skills in leadership, competitive strategy, business planning, marketing and data analytics will help you achieve your goals.

ESPORTS MANAGEMENT

The BBA concentration in esports management is designed to prepare individuals for careers in esports administration and management with interscholastic, intercollegiate and professional esports organizations, esports event organizers, entrepreneurial esports ventures and more.

HEALTHCARE MANAGEMENT

The healthcare management concentration integrates the biological sciences with core business courses to prepare leaders for the complex challenges of the continuously evolving health care industry. Health care administration and leadership is a rapidly growing field that provides the expertise needed to manage health care organizations that are changing to meet the needs of an expanding and aging population.

INFORMATION SYSTEMS & TECHNOLOGIES

Students who choose the information systems and technologies concentration learn how to use technology to achieve organizational goals through effective utilization of computer technology and resources. Students apply practical and theoretical learning to problem solving and systems development.

MANAGEMENT

In this concentraton, you'll develop an awareness of management functions, theory and skills within local and global environments. You'll learn to use both quantitative and behavioral methods to achieve organizational goals through effective utilization of human and material resources.

MARKETING

The marketing concentration focuses on contemporary marketing trends, industrial needs and marketing management skills practiced today. You'll also address actual marketing problems confronted by various types of organizations.

SPORT MANAGEMENT

Sport managers help athletes and entire organizations run their operations smoothly, managing corporate image and serving as intermediaries between players and teams. Shenandoah's sport management program combines a solid foundation in business management with courses in marketing, ethics, facility planning and sports law.

ESPORTS MANAGEMENT (BS)

The Bachelor of Science in esports management is designed to prepare individuals for careers in esports management with interscholastic, intercollegiate and professional esports organizations, entrepreneurial esports ventures and more. This program provides a robust esports background with a focus in business management. You will gain one-of-a-kind experiences through international partnerships and at our state-of-the-art esports arena.

ESPORTS MEDIA AND COMMUNICATION (BS)

The Bachelor of Science in esports media and communication prepares students for a career in the broadcast and production side of esports. Through collaborative international experiences with esports employees and players from around the world and trips abroad, internships with major esports and video game companies, and hands-on experiences with industry executives as well as the varsity esports team at Shenandoah, students will be ready for careers as esports event producers, broadcasters, streamers and more.
