

► Doctor of Philosophy: Organizational Leadership (Ph.D.)

Our Ph.D. in organizational leadership is designed to appeal to professionals in institutions of public trust such as community-based nonprofits, public and private sector organizations, and higher education.

Key Features:

- Flexibility in design across all coursework allows for optimal learning in one's specific area of interest in the 60-credit program
- Integration of theory with real-world problems and the learner's lived experience
- Individualized focus: students choose their concentration and capstone product
- Low-residency Hybrid model: 2 weekends on-campus per semester and 2 summer residencies (one week duration); all coursework completed online in a supportive online environment that includes synchronous virtual meetings with faculty

The 30-credit MA in Strategic Narrative Communication program empowers students to craft compelling narratives that captivate audiences and drive meaningful change. This innovative curriculum seamlessly blends narrative theory with hands-on training, immersing students in the art and science of narrative design across diverse mediums and emerging technologies. Students delve into the transformative power of storytelling as a strategic communication tool, learning to build brands, influence audiences and effect change.

- Provides a robust foundation in narrative principles, audience analysis and multi-platform storytelling techniques.

APPLIED BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS

College of Arts and Sciences

Applied behavior analysis (ABA) is an evidence-based approach to teaching and behavior support that involves analyzing and understanding the unique personal and environmental circumstances that influence and affect one's behavior.

Our ABA programs teach students to conduct ABA therapy from a place of compassion with an emphasis on individualized client-centered and assent-based procedures. Students learn how to utilize ABA approaches for a variety of individuals and contexts, including supporting neurodivergent learners, students in the classroom, and employees in business and organizational settings.

- · Designed to accommodate individuals who are employed full or part time
- Curricula are designed to meet both the 5th Edition and 6th edition coursework requirements as mandated by the behavior analyst certification board
- BCBA career options include, but are not limited to: clinical supervisor, school-support personnel, parent trainer, behavior consultant, health coach, researcher, ABA therapist, social worker, human resource consultant, or nonprofit sector work designing behavioral programs
- \$50,000-\$100,000 starting salary range for BCBAs

- Nationally and regionally renowned faculty mentors
- Certified by the International Behavior Analysis Organization (IBAO), which allows international students to complete the academic requirements to sit for the IBAO's certification exam
- Fully online program with classes meeting both asynchronously and synchronously
- Programs meet behavior-analytic coursework requirements for BCBA and BCaBA certification.

► Master of Science in Applied Behavior Analysis (M.S. ABA)

Our ABA master's degree is designed to develop the knowledge, skills and ethical standards necessary to practice competently. Our program consists of 33 credit hours, including 21 credit hours of required coursework, 6 credit hours of electives, and 6 credit hours for a final capstone project. Students arrange their own fieldwork supervision with recommendations and support from SU faculty. During the program, faculty meet with the students to review their supervision progress.

► Graduate Certificate in Applied Behavior Analysis

Our 21-credit, seven-course sequence is designed for students who already hold a master's degree or are currently pursuing a master's degree in another content area. The curriculum includes 21 credit hours of required coursework without an elective or capstone requirement.

CLINICAL MENTAL HEALTH COUNSELING

School of Health Professions



Our 60-credit Clinical Mental Health Counseling program provides students with the knowledge and skills to deliver individual and group counseling services grounded in evidence-based practices. Students develop their theoretical orientation through coursework, practicum, and internships and will learn ethical and legal foundations as well as diverse content to work with varied clientele and diagnoses.

Key Features:

- Career growth expected in substance abuse, behavioral disorders, and mental health counseling, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics' Occupational Outlook Handbook
- 70% of courses are online with 30% in-person fieldwork and practicum experiences
- Collaboration with graduate health professions students in other disciplines at Shenandoah to understand biological, psychological, social and environmental factors impacting health and development
- Part-time option available for working professionals

MUSIC THERAPY AND PROFESSIONAL COUNSELING

Shenandoah Conservatory

► Master of Arts in Music Therapy and Professional Counseling (M.A.)

The Master of Arts in Music Therapy and Professional Counseling program integrates clinical mental health counseling and music therapy coursework to provide a comprehensive education emphasizing ethical and culturally responsive treatment strategies. This degree fulfills the academic requirements to become a nationally board certified Music Therapist (MT-BC) and Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC) in Virginia.

Key Features:

- A combined degree in clinical mental health counseling and music therapy provides a diversified job outlook by including the integration of job skills in inpatient, outpatient, or residential settings.
- 18% career growth expected in the next year in substance abuse, behavioral disorders, and mental health counseling, according to the Bureau of Labor Statistics' Occupational Outlook Handbook

► Doctor of Philosophy: Educational Leadership (Ph.D.)

Our Ph.D. is a part-time, low-residency program designed for experienced professionals in PreK–12, higher education, and education-related fields. Students engage in rigorous research, collaborate with peers and faculty, and explore complex educational issues with the goal of advancing equity, innovation, and leadership in diverse learning environments.

- Cohort-based learning that fosters scholarly community and collaboration
- Hands-on research mentorship through faculty-led projects at various stages

► Doctor of Education: Educational Leadership (Ed.D.)

The part-time Ed.D. degree offers innovative, inquiry-based preparation to meet the current realities and future needs of PreK-12 and higher education leaders and their organizations. Mid- and senior-career professionals leverage practical experience, theory, and research skills to analyze and positively impact complex problems of practice. The 50-59 credit degree includes a concentration and culminates with a dissertation research study. This program is a member of the Carnegie Project on the Education Doctorate (CPED).

The part-time Ed.S. degree offers innovative, inquiry-based preparation to meet the current realities and future needs of PreK-12 and higher education leaders and their organizations. In this 36-credit program, mid- and senior-career professionals leverage practical experience, theory, and research skills to analyze and positively impact complex problems of practice. This two-year degree is designed for professionals who hold a master's degree and seek advanced preparation in educational leadership. The program culminates with a capstone course.

- Flexible low-residency model combines three Saturday inperson classes per semester (Winchester or Loudoun) with weekday evening Zoom classes and asynchronous study.
- Cohort-based learning that fosters scholarly community, peer support, and collaboration
- Scholarly practitioner research focus

▶ Master of Science in Education (M.S.Ed.): Education Administration

Our 30-credit program is designed for professionals in Virginia's public and private schools and leads to licensure in administration and supervision, which may also be recognized in other states through reciprocity agreements.

► Professional Studies Certificate: Administration & Supervision

Our 21-credit certification program leads to licensure in administration and supervision for professionals in Virginia public schools who already hold a master's degree, and may also be recognized in other states through reciprocity agreements.

CERTIFICATES

► Initial Teacher Licensure Post-Baccalaureate Certificates

You'll complete coursework necessary to earn Virginia licensure and gain 300-500+hours of hands-on classroom experience through an internship or, if provisionally licensed, mentorship courses. Classes are taught by faculty who hold terminal degrees and K-12 teaching licenses. Our programs are fully accredited by CAEP. You'll construct an e-portfolio, create a teacher work sample and complete assignments that align directly with real classroom situations.

The program is developed so a student may begin with any of the four courses.

▶ Master of Science in Literacy Education (M.S.)

Our 30-credit program is a teacher-oriented program that addresses the complex field of literacy by offering three core literacy courses for all participants and a choice of concentrations in writing, reading, early literacy, and individual design, with each course of study designed to explore literacy areas in depth.

► Post-Master's Certificate: Reading Licensure

Our 21-credit certificate for reading licensure serves teachers who already hold a master's degree from a regionally accredited institution of higher education and who want to obtain Virginia licensure as a reading specialist. Each course in the program highlights evidence-based practices in reading and writing instruction.

- Curriculum includes community engagement opportunities such as the Shenandoah Valley Writing Project/ Project Write, Inc., and Camp Read-A-Lot
- Courses offer increased flexibility with many including online synchronous sessions
- Shenandoah has hosted its annual Children's Literature Conference attracting top children's authors and illustrators (including multiple Newberry and Caldecott winners) for more than 30 summers. Participation can also lead to continuing education credit.

► Master of Science in Education (M.S.Ed.)

▷ Special Education

Our program prepares pre-service, alternatively licensed, or already certified teachers to meet eligibility requirements for licensure and endorsement in Special Education-General Education Curriculum, K-12.

► Special Education Licensure Post-Baccalaureate Certificate, K-12

Our 30-39 credit K-12 special education graduate certificate serves those who desire Virginia special education teacher licensure through the use of the newest instructional techniques, experiential learning and exposure to information related to classroom management, and instructional strategies for delivery to a K-12 school population.

► Special Education Licensure, Add-on endorsement certificates

Teachers completing one of these 15-credit graduate certificates will meet the Virginia Department of Education (VDOE) requirements for grade-banded, add-on endorsement in one of three levels: Special Education Elementary K-6, Middle 6-8, or Secondary 6-12 instruction. Fifty hours of field experiences are embedded in the courses for each endorsement.
