

South Campus Commons Pool Rules

- The pool will only be open and available during posted hours of operation if and only if a staff member is present. This facility will operate as a **Swim at your Own Risk** facility if a staff member is present, but no lifeguard is on duty. It is our goal to have a lifeguard present whenever possible, but due to staffing issues, cannot guarantee it. Users are encouraged to exercise caution.
- All patrons must show Shenandoah University ID Card and sign in immediately upon arrival
- Guests will only be permitted if accompanied by an SU Student, Faculty, or Staff member
- No one is allowed in the pool area without the presence of a Campus Recreation & Wellness staff member
- No alcoholic beverages or glass containers
 - No glass items (cups, plates, bottles, etc.) are allowed in the pool area
- No use of tobacco products including vapor and alternative nicotine products
- The maximum capacity in the pool area is 50.
- Earbuds must be worn while listening to personal music
- The following are strictly prohibited: running, pushing and unsafe play; spitting, spouting or regurgitating water; pulling, sitting, tugging or hanging on lane lines, and any other similar types of acts generally considered being unacceptable pool behavior
- Service Animals will be the only animals permitted inside the fenced area
- No users experiencing illness, skin, eye or ear infection or conditions with open wounds will be permitted in the pool
- NO DIVING is permitted in the pool.
- Proper swimwear must be worn by all pool users (No jeans, athletic shorts/pants, cotton t-shirts, compression shorts or underwear) (staff reserves the right to ask non-compliant patrons to leave)
- Pool toys and large floats are prohibited. Kickboards and swim noodles are permitted.
- No running or rough play permitted
- Anyone violating these rules will be asked to leave the pool area
- Shenandoah University reserves the right to close the pool based on weather, water chemistry, staffing issues, or other circumstances that may impact the safety of the pool users, pool staff, and the Shenandoah community
