I am writing in reference to the employment opportunity as a Physical Therapist at EXOS in Sebastian, Florida. In December of 2018, I will be graduating Shenandoah University with a Doctorate of Physical Therapy and a Master of Science in Athletic Training. I originally found out about EXOS during the summer of 2015, when I was enrolled in Athletic Training courses and planning my future. I have also had the opportunity to hone my skills by becoming a Certified Strength and Conditioning Specialist through the National Strength and Conditioning Association, certified as a Level 1 Graston Provider for soft tissue mobilization, Certified as a Level 2 Functional Movement Screen specialist for movement associated impairments, and certified as a nutrition specialist through the International Society of Sports Nutrition. Additionally, I hold a Master's Degree in Exercise Physiology.
