Advanced Programs

Administration & Supervision

School Leaders Licensure Assessment (SLLA)

The SLLA 6990, developed by ETS, is required to receive an Administration and Supervision Endorsement from Virginia (Assessment Requirements VA Licensure 2021). The SLLA is not a requirement to graduate from the Ed Adm. program, but in order for completers to receive a Virginia Administration & Supervision Endorsement, they must provide their official SLLA results to SU's Office of Professional Licensure. Ten completers took the official SLLA. Their results are presented in Table A1.

The total passing score for the SLLA is 146. All 2024-25 completers who took the official SLLA passed, for a pass rate of 100% and an average overall score of 173. All content categories were above an average of 70% correct.

Reading Specialist

Reading for Virginia Educators (RVE)

The Reading for Virginia Educators (RVE) is the Praxis Series for reading specialists. The RVE is a requirement for licensure for advanced endorsement in Reading Specialists. The test aims to determine if entry-level reading specialists have the knowledge, skills, and abilities that are important, necessary, and needed at the time of entry to the profession to teach reading. The RVE is taken the semester before completion of the Reading Specialist program.

For 2024-25 Reading Specialist completers, the RVE pass rate was 100%. The mean score was 176, with a standard deviation of 6.07 and a median score of 175. The minimum passing score on the RVE is 162, and the maximum score is 200.
