

4.2. CAEP Accountability Measures - 2024-2025 Academic Year

EPPs are required to provide data addressing the four CAEP Accountability Measures. These data must be collected or reported for the 2024-2025 Academic Year (September 1, 2024, to August 31, 2025) and be relevant to the requirements outlined below.

Measure 2 (Initial and Advanced): Satisfaction of employers and stakeholder involvement.

Data provided should be collected on employers’ satisfaction with program completers.

Advanced Programs

As noted for the Initial Programs above, SU has been a participating member since 2019 in the Virginia Education Assessment Collaborative (VEAC), and when VEAC expanded its services to Advanced Programs in 2022, SU joined in that pilot study. Because P- 12 systems differ widely, individual administrators have different situations in which to report impressions of their completers' preparation, and smaller numbers of Advanced Completers per school also affected the process. The VEAC survey aligns with each advanced program’s national standards as well as Virginia’s VUPS, and the use of a shared survey protocol has improved response rates compared with prior SU-designed surveys.

Respondent employers could respond “fully ready, mostly ready, moderately ready, minimally ready, or not ready.” To find the average overall satisfaction, responses are coded from 1 to 5. Higher values indicate more satisfaction, and lower values indicate more dissatisfaction.
