The Amy Barnes College Scholarship (\$2,000)

Amy Barnes was the "Founding Mother," of the local National Federation of the Blind Winchester, VA Chapter in the early 1960's. The Chapter started out as the Winchester Association of the Blind. It eventually became a Chapter of the National Federation of the Blind. Amy was the longest serving Chapter President, and was an active member well into the 21st century.

This scholarship is for any legally blind or low vision student attending college who's legal residence is currently in the Shenandoah Valley area, or who graduated from a Shenandoah Valley area high school.

Blindness or low vision is defined by: Loss of vision that cannot be correct by eye glasses or contact lenses.
