**Scope and Content:** The items in this collection contain letters, photographs, and ephemera related to the Civil War service of Corporal Robert Bradbury. The collection's core consists of

twenty-nine wartime letters. The majority of Bradbury's letters focus on the Civil War in the northern Shenandoah Valley. Bradbury, born in 1844, enlisted in Battery D, First Pennsylvania Light Artillery on August 26, 1862. He mustered out of service on June 21, 1865. After the conflict Bradbury worked as a clerk at John Wanamaker's department store in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania and also as a truancy officer. He was also an active member of the E.D. Baker Post No. 8, Grand Army of the Republic in Philadelphia. He died on September 30, 1909, after falling from the North American Real Estate Trust Building in Philadelphia. He is buried in West Laurel Hill Cemetery
