
# Shenandoah University's McCormick Civil War Institute Spring 2026 Conference

# "Quenching the Embers" Victory, Defeat, and Challenges After Appomattox

Saturday, April 18, 2026

On the campus of Shenandoah University, Winchester, Virginia 8:30 a.m.-4 p.m.



As the Civil War neared its end in the spring of 1865 and in its immediate aftermath, Lieutenant General Ulysses S. Grant, although jubilant over the Union's military triumph, recognized that there were still "embers of the great rebellion" that needed "quenching." The McCormick Civil War Institute's spring 2026 conference will explore some of the challenges the nation confronted in the Civil War's final days and its immediate aftermath, including dealing with Confederate officials who scattered in various directions during the Confederacy's final days, the parole of Confederate troops and the demobilization of the Army of Northern Virginia, concerns about how political unrest in Mexico could reignite the conflict, President

Andrew Johnson's perspective on Reconstruction and the efforts of Radical Republicans to challenge Johnson.
