Course Name: NMLB 651: Integrated Midwifery Internship

Clinical time requirement: 300 Clinical Hours + Number of Experiences

Scope: Integration of Primary Care, Preconception Care, Antepartal Care, Women's Health/Gynecologic Care including Contraception, STI screening and treatment, Intrapartum, Postpartum, Neonatal Exam and Breastfeeding.

Course objectives:

- 1. Incorporate evidence-based care into clinical practice.
- 2. Promote person-centered care, which respects and is inclusive of diverse histories, backgrounds and identities.
- 3. Identify problems or diagnoses and health care needs based on correct interpretation of the subjective and objective data.
- 4. Identify deviations from normal and appropriate interventions, including collaboration and referral as indicated.
- 5. Evaluate effectiveness of treatments and/or interventions

To document student attendance and progress, you will be asked to participate in a 15 minute virtual site visit (zoom or phone call) and complete an online midterm evaluation and final evaluation during this semester.

Per requirements from the Accreditation Commission for Midwifery Education (ACME), we will need the following:

- Provider license (CNM, CM, NP, PA or MD)
- Curriculum Vitae or Résumé
